# "Pittsburgh Project" Commissioning Litany

Leader: In Matthew's gospel, Jesus tells us to go and make disciples (28:19). In the gospel of Mark, Jesus calls us to go and tell the good news to everyone, everywhere (16:15). In the gospel of Luke, Jesus promises to send the Holy Spirit to be with us (24:49). And in the gospel of John, Jesus says, "As the Father has sent me, I am sending you" (20:21).

What is a mission? It is sending forth people somewhere to serve. God sends people on a mission.

What is a commission? It is granting authority, allowing us to act on behalf of another. God commissions people to go for him.
