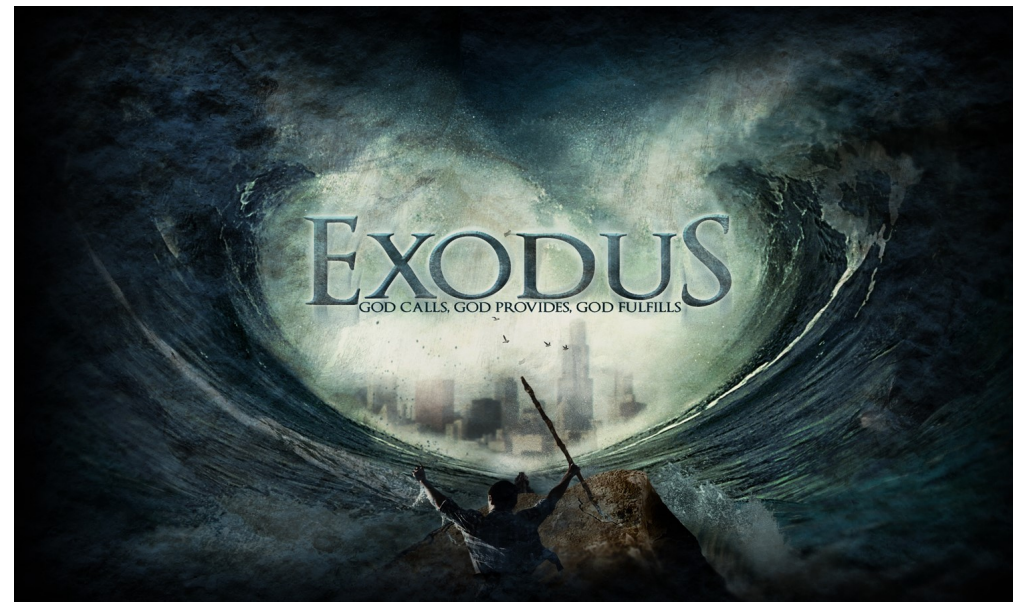

RENEWAL OF BAPTISMAL VOWS

L: In your baptism, God acted out of grace and love for you. You entered the covenant God established. You were joined to Christ and welcomed into the household of faith. The grace of God is eternal. Nothing can separate you from God’s love. You are still God’s child, and God cares for you. I ask you therefore, once again to reject sin, to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, and to confess the faith of the church, the faith in which we are baptized.

L: Trusting in the gracious mercy of God, do you turn from the ways of sin and renounce evil and its power in the world?

**P: I do.**

L: Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Lord and Savior, trusting in his grace and love?

**P: I do.**

L: Will you be Christ’s faithful disciple, obeying his Word and showing his love?

**P: I will, with God’s help.**

PROFESSION OF FAITH

L: Do you believe in God the Father?

**P: I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.**

L: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

**P: I believe in Jesus Christ, God’s only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.**

L: Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

**P: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.**

L: You have publicly professed your faith. Will you continue to be a faithful member of this congregation, sharing in its worship and ministry through your prayers and gifts, your study and service, and so fulfill your calling to be a disciple of Jesus Christ?

**P: I will, with God’s help.**

L: Faithful God, in baptism you claimed us; and by your Spirit you are working in our lives, empowering us to live lives worthy of our calling. We thank you for leading us to this time and place of reaffirming the covenant you made with us in our baptism. Establish us in your truth and guide us by your Spirit, daily increase in us your gifts of grace: the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord, the spirit of joy in your presence, both now and forever, that, together with all your people, we may grow in faith, hope, and love, and be faithful disciples of Jesus Christ, to whom, with you and the Holy Spirit, be honor and glory, now and forever.

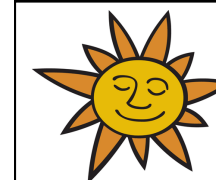
**GET RID OF YOUR LOOSE CHANGE**
